f. Future Projects:

- 1) New dance floor: Banks received updated pricing on new dance floor for the pavilion, which will need to be incorporated into the 2023-2024 budget.
- 2) Shade cloth replacement: We still need to pull one of the old shade cloths out of storage to take measurements and seek price quotes from sail or awning manufacturers.
- 3) Mural Project: Banks reported that the Lake Odessa Downtown Development Authority is interested in working with the Arts Commission on a mural project. She stated that a \$4,000 mini-grant could be applied for. The deadline for grant applications is January 23. Sites can be identified and muralists contacted during 2023, and a grant application submitted in January 2024.
